Banyan Fields Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

In 2021 Banyan Fields Primary School will be working with a new stationery supplier, due to a number of challenges and delays during 2020.

Please note charges vary for each year level. Please take care when making payments, so you enter the correct amount.

The school will be accepting payments from 5th October 2020.

Financial Support for Families

Banyan Fields Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund
 - If you have a Health Care Card in the parent/carer's name with your child/children listed, you may be eligible to apply. A Camps, Sports, Excursion Fund application form is enclosed for your convenience.
 - In order to process your CSEF application, you will need to provide the school with your current
 Health Care Card which must be valid as of 27th January 2021. Please email your application together
 with your Health Care Card to banyan.fields.ps@education.vic.gov.au We can only accept Camps,
 Sports, Excursion Fund (CSEF) application forms together with your current Health Care Card (these
 documents cannot be received individually) in order to enter your application.

2021 Parent Payment

To avoid delay in delivery of items for the 2021 school year we will be introducing a deposit for the 2021 Essential Student Learning Items. Families can pay a deposit of \$15 per child by Tuesday 17th November 2020 for their 2021 Essential Student Learning Items. Any family that pays their deposit by this date will have their stationery items ordered in term 4 2020 with delivery for these expected on the first day of term 1, 2021.

* All deposits are non-refundable and will be used in the event of non-payment to cover the costs to the supplier for restocking and returning the items.

Round 1

Receipt of stationery pack

To receive your stationery pack in the first week of term 1, full payment for the 2021 Essential Student Learning Items must be received no later than 9th December 2020.

Please note that if full payment of 2021 Essential Student Learning Items is not received by Friday 19th February 2021 then you will forfeit your deposit and the items will be returned to the supplier.

Round 2

Receipt of stationery pack

To order a stationery pack in the second round, full payment of the 2021 Essential Student Learning Items for each child must be received no later than Friday 19th February 2021.

It is expected that items ordered in the second round will be received by the end of term 1 but this is not guaranteed and is dependent on continued Covid-19 disruptions.
