

Remote Learning Tasks Year 3

Dear Students and Parents/Carers,

With the extension of remote learning we have added a few supports for this week, along with some new learning tasks. **Monday, Tuesday, Thursday** and **Friday** will be focused on 2 x Literacy and 1 x Numeracy tasks per day. **Wednesday** will be Specialist class day, tasks set for this day will cover Health and Wellbeing, PE, Art and Science.
